Please join the clergy of our diocese in a prayerful celebration for the 67th Anniversary of the Diocese of St. Catharines. A reception will follow.

FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

The Feast of Christ the King was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925 as an antidote to secularism, a way of life which leaves God out of man's thinking and living and organizes hi life as if God did not exist. The feast is intended to proclaim in a striking and effective manner Christ's royalty over individuals, families, society governments, and nations. Today's Mass establishes the titles for Christ's royalty over men: Christ is God, the Creator of the universe and hence wields a supreme power over all things; "All things were created by Him"; Christ is our Redeemer, He purchased us by His precious Blood, and made us His property and possession; Christ is Head of the Church, "holding in all things the primacy"; God bestowed upon Christ the nations of the world as his special possession and dominion. Today's Mass also describes the qualities of Christ's kingdom. This kingdom is: supreme, extending not only to all peoples but also to their princes and kings; universal, extending to all nations and to all places; eternal, for "The Lord shall sit a King forever"; spiritual, Christ's "kingdom is not of this world".
